



## SCHOOL EXAMINATION POLICY

1. The table below indicates the various codes which will be printed on the result slips of students who are absent for any component/paper during an examination.

Code	Reasons For Absence	School's Decision
AB	Absent <u>without</u> a valid reason	Student will get '0' for any component/paper missed.
MC	Absent with a medical certificate	The computation of the Overall Results will include only the component(s)/paper(s) students sat for.
VR	Absent with a valid reason <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Official documents must be submitted to the Form Teachers.</li></ul> (Examination Committee and School Leaders will approve on case by case basis.)
